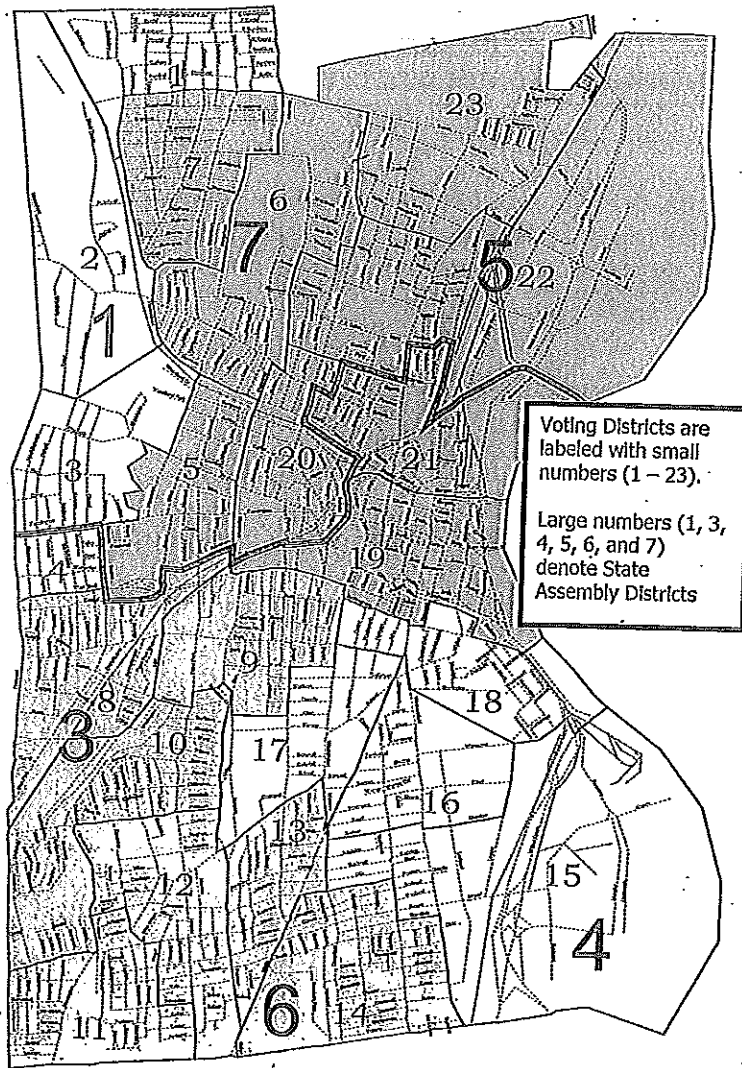


# Voting District Map

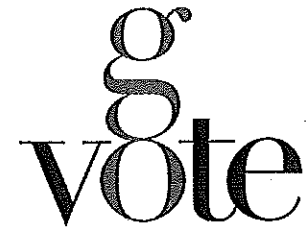
### Ballot Question - Vote yes or no
